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#### **Board of Directors Meeting Minutes**

Monday, September 21, 2020 2:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Via Zoom

- I. Call to Order by the Chair, Trevor Getz
  - There being a quorum present, the University Corporation, San Francisco State (UCorp) Board of Directors was called to order by the chair, Trevor Getz, at 2:32pm via Zoom due to shelter-inplace order.

- II. Public Comment
  - 1. Guidelines: Public comment time is limited to fifteen minutes total, with three minutes per speaker, and is limited to UCorp business.
- III. Constituent Reports
  - Teddy Albiniak introduced himself and expressed how thankful he is to be part of the UCORP Board of Directors.
- IV. Report from the Finance Committee Chair, Kal Salama
  - Research for the Line of Credit is still being done. Will be a topic of discussion for the Finance Committee tomorrow.



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- Stock market has been large cap driven by tech that has come back into the positive. The rest of the markets are still down for the year.
- Bonds have done well because interest rates have fallen this year.
- Fixed incomes are right on target.
- Portfolio YTD up 4.9%. Fiscal year to-date up 6.3% (July and August) Strong start to the FY.
- Alternatives YTD down 10%. During both the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter, both our property holdings were marked down proactively; anticipating a loss in income from renters leaving or not paying. However, our occupancy is still 93-94%. Most of the rent is still being paid. Compared to other real estate we are doing well. Not sure if it will continue this way.
- V. Report from the Associate Vice President, Tammie Ridgell
  - UCORP audit has been completed without findings. Will offer more details once the Audit Committee has reviewed and accepted the report.
  - A revised budget will be submitted at the next Board meeting, that will include the recent announcement of Spring semester being done remotely.
  - FSR will be presented at the next Board meeting.
- VI. Report from the Director of Operations, Chris Farmer
  - At last BOD meeting we discussed rent deferral for the food vendors for the Fall term. Shortly
    after that a Budget and Logistics committee was put together. Some food services will be
    available on campus (Station Café, Café Rosso, Café 101, Halal Shop, Lobby Shop, Gators
    Groceries, Ctrl+P, Bookstore)
  - Ctrl+P worked on the campus signage.
  - Bookstore needed to continue operating during the Fall semester. Worked with the campus to
    make it easier to find the store online. We are trying to do everything we can to support them.
  - Closed down the vending machines that were not needed due to buildings being closed and refreshed the items in the machines that are still in use.
  - Will likely defer vendors rent for the Spring semester.
  - U-Club furniture has been delivered and set up.
- VII. Report from the Executive Director, Jason Porth
  - This will be a very difficult year. Many of our colleagues have received lay-off notices.
  - Manzanita Square can hold up to 592 residents but there are fewer than 150 currently living there. 1 student per bedroom. The retail is empty right now and will likely stay empty a little longer than anticipated. However, there is a long list of interested partners Amazon being one of them. Follett is also interested (more of a campus spirit store much like Seattle University).
  - Line of credit to be discussed further at tomorrows Finance Committee meeting.
  - There were 2 people on site at the Sierra Nevada Field Campus for deferred maintenance projects. They managed to keep things up and running.
